



Overall margin of error for today's data: +/- 2.83%










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
MOST IMPORTANT ISSUE FACING TEXAS (FEBRUARY 2022)



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


TEXAS SPENDING ON BORDER SECURITY (OCTOBER 2021)





GREG ABBOTT JOB APPROVAL: IMMIGRATION AND BORDER SECURITY (FEBRUARY 2022)








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
JOE BIDEN JOB APPROVAL TREND (FEBRUARY 2021 TO FEBRUARY 2022)










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


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
DIRECTION OF TEXAS (OCTOBER 2009 TO FEBRUARY 2022)







Some takeaways

Overall public opinion environment adds to prevailing Republican electoral advantages in Texas.

Campaigns likely to want to avoid emphasis on some issues that intense partisans and activists will want to hear about.

Independents are in a bad mood and unpredictable...but advantage likely remains with GOP.




TEXAS REPUBLICAN PARTY IDEOLOGICAL IDENTIFICATION




Negative partisanship - working definition


The tendency of a voters' identification with one party to be significantly or primarily driven by hostility toward the other party.
